





1. Remove the front panel at the lower left and turn on the Battery Enable switch. Replace the panel.






Front Panel, Battery Enable Switch


2. Turn on the main AC power switch at the rear of the unit.



Removing the Freezer from the Shipping Pallets



CAUTION! This freezer is heavy. Be sure you have enough personnel moving the freezer to prevent tipping.



To remove the freezer from the shipping pallets:

- 1. Remove and discard the shipping plastic.
- 2. Using a 1/2" combination wrench and phillips, remove all screws securing the shipping brackets to the pallet.
- 3. Discard all shipping brackets.
- 4. Remove the ramp boards from the shipping pallet and locate the slotted end over the ramp brackets with the support blocks on the underside.
- 5. Align the casters with the ramp boards.
- 6. Be sure to use enough personnel to roll the freezer off the pallet. Brace the pallet on the opposite side to prevent tipping.






Front Panel, Battery Enable Switch






Control Panel with Key Switch


