# MARCH MHPC PRINT COMPETITION

At the March 16 Mid-Hudson Photography Club meeting we will have a print competition using the PPA rules. MHPC member and Master Photographer Frank Dispensa will run the judging.

Frank has recommended that prints be made about 15% darker to compensate for the print illumination that is used in this judging. (NOTE: For our purposes any print that is nice and saturated will do)

These rules will apply:

- 1- The entry must have been captured and created by the entrant.
- 2- The entrants name cannot appear on the face of the entry.
- 3- A maximum of four entries may be submitted by an entrant.
- 4- No entry will be eligible that was made under the supervision of an instructor or as a class assignment.
- 5- No two entries shall be of the same subject.
- 6- Entries may be color or B&W prints

#### MOUNTING

- 1- Print entries must be permanently mounted on standard mount board material. No masonite, glass, stretcher or conventional frames allowed.
- 2- Images of any shape or size are allowed and must be mounted on 16 x 20 mount board (recommended mounting thickness is 1/8" to 3/8"
- 3- No material may be added to the front or back of an entry that may damage another entry.
