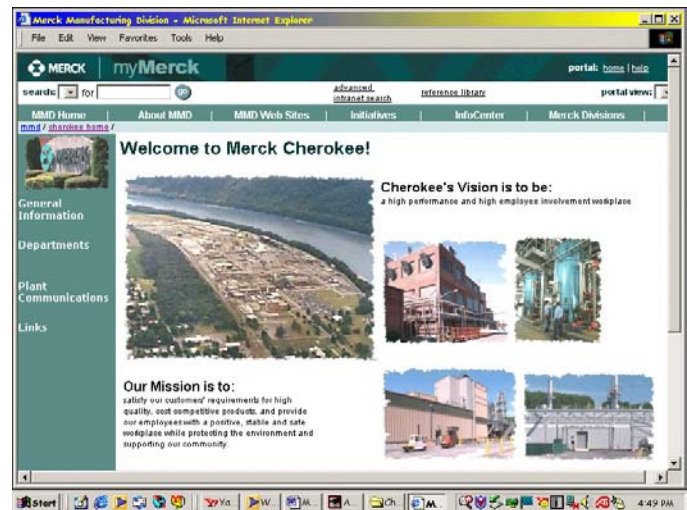
The Opportunity
