Limited availabilty on Friday, July 4th. On PA Rt. 611, convenient to both the East-West PA Turnpike (Rt. 276) and the Northeast Extention of the PA Turnpike (Rt. 476). All rooms have refrigerator and microwave, free breakfast, small indoor pool. 8 miles from Christa's house, 13 miles from Reunion Site.
- Springhill Suites Philadelphia/Willow Grove, 2480 Maryland Road, Willow Grove, PA 19090 (215)657-7800. Group rate \$109/night (King), \$119/night (2 Queen beds) -- ask for Ruddy Reunion before June 5th. Off PA Rt. 611, at the East-West PA Turnpike (Rt. 276) Willow Grove exit. All rooms are suites with separate living area with sofa bed, refrigerator and microwave, free breakfast, indoor pool. 16 miles from Christa's house, 21 miles from Reunion Site.

- Towneplace Suites Philadelphia/Horsham, 198 Precision Drive, Horsham, PA 19044 (215)323-9900 Group rate \$119/night (Studio), \$169/night (2-br suite) -- ask for Ruddy Reunion before June 5th. Limited availability on Friday, July 4th. Off PA Rt. 611, convenient to the East-West PA Turnpike (Rt. 276). All rooms are suites with full kitchens, outdoor pool. 14 miles from Christa's house, 19 miles from Reunion Site.
- The Inn at Lambertville Station is walking distance to the reunion location, but it's probably not kid-friendly and runs \$225-\$305/night. They are booked for Friday night, but that does free up the option to stay only one night. Ask for Ruddy Reunion. 6 miles from Christa's house, 0.25 miles from Reunion Site.
- New Hope and Lambertville B&B's: There are a ton of B&B's in Lambertville and across the river in New Hope, PA, but most will require a 3-day stay on the hoilday weekend. Also, many do not allow children. However, if you are into B&B's, these are all quite nice, and many will be within walking distance of the Reunion.
- Hampton Inn Flemington, 14 Royal Road, Flemington, NJ 08822, (908)284-9427. For those of you coming from eastern NY and New England, Flemington, NJ, would be on your way. No block of rooms here, but the list price on their website is \$129/night. All rooms have refrigerator and microwave, free breakfast, small indoor pool. 22 miles from Christa's house, 13 miles from Reunion Site.

From the East and North -- US202 South:

about 2-1/2 blocks up on the left.

Follow US202 South through Flemington towards PA. Take the Rt. 179 South exit toward Lambertville. Follow Rt. 179 about 5 miles into Lambertville. Turn **RIGHT** onto Bridge St./Rt. 179. The church is about 2 blocks down on the right.

## From the South -- I-95 North:

If you're coming from further south than Philadelphia, you're better off following the directions from the West. Follow I-95 North into NJ and take Exit 1 Rt. 29. Follow Rt. 29 North towards Lambertville. Follow Rt. 29 North about 9 miles. Turn **Left** onto Bridge St./Rt. 179. The church is about 2 blocks down on the right.

- O To the picnic: From the church turn right towards the river. Just before the bridge, turn left into the Inn at Lambertville Station parking lot. DO NOT PAY TO PARK. Follow the small road around the left side of the inn back about 1/4 mile along the river. The boat club is a small wooden building on the right. Park along the road on either side.
