

The main Wine Cellar window offers an easy, intuitive interface for browsing your inventory and recent tasting notes. Preprogrammed reports are available to summarize and/or list wine inventories, tasting notes, and rankings. Program options allow wines to be sorted by name or by year; even the window's foreground and background colors are easily changed to please any connoisseur.




Tremendous data capacity and flexibility are available through wine and tasting note comments. A wine's cellar location and/or purchase date may be included in the wine comment and the evening's menu can be saved to detail a particular wine tasting.



Data entry screens offer hidden tricks such as associating a flag icon with each wine classification.

After two or more tasting notes have been recorded for a particular vintage, double clicking on the wine bottle icon in the main window generates a chart showing the tasting scores across time.

Although the Davis Scoring System is the default, the rating categories may be changed to suit the needs of any wine enthusiast.

Wine data can be searched for (and retrieved) in a variety of ways. For example, wine comments and/or tasting notes can be searched for the appearance of keywords. Additionally, tasting notes between two specified dates or those recorded during the most recent days, months, or years are easy to locate using the programs built-in search capibilities.
